- · Lexington step 22. Do not install the safety rail. It will be · Install wall slats in the postions shown above, using the used for the picnic table.
- · Install the swing beam. Instructions and hardware are in the 9' Swing Beam Leg Carton (63060-222).
- · Install the Picnic Table (SD204-102Q).
- · Install the Monkey Bars (63079-102). Mount one side directly to the corner post as shown above.
- · Mount the Rock Climbing Wall (AH201-102Q) in the position shown.

- Secure the access ladder next to the rock wall using the method shown in step 20 of the Lexington instructions.
- · Install the slide mount and slide using the method shown in steps 28 and 29 of the Lexington instructions.
- methods from the Lexington instructions. Gaps must be narrower than 3-1/2" or wider than 9" to prevent potential head entrapment.
- · Mount the hand grips to the entrance wall slats.
- · Double-check all fasteners are secure and all recessed hardware is covered by hole caps.
